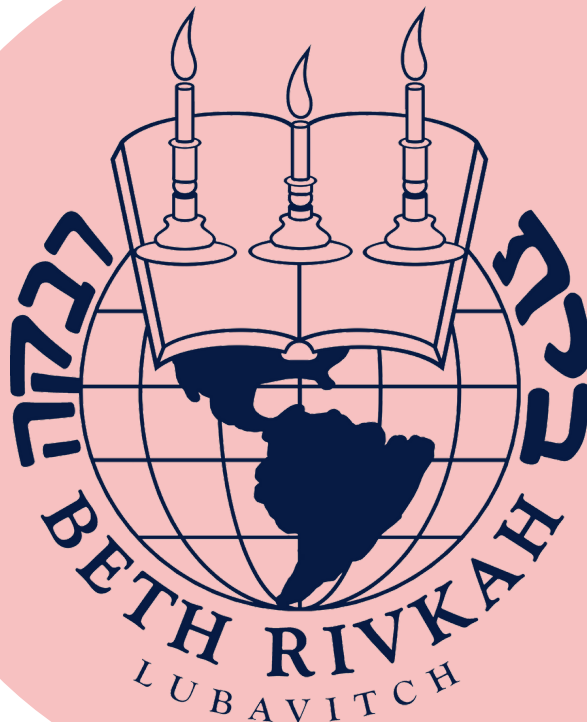

Arrival

Arrival

Pre-1A: Students can be dropped off starting 8:45 am. Parents or guardians should accompany them to their classrooms.

Transition: You can drop off your daughter from 8:45 – 9:00 A.M. by the tent on Lefferts Ave, Exit 3. A staff member will be waiting until 9:15 A.M. to greet the students and bring them to their classrooms.



Bus Safety

- Students should wait for the bus on the sidewalk – always away from the curb.
- They should not step into the street until the bus has come to a complete stop and the driver has opened the door to the bus.
- Children must never run after the bus; if they miss the bus, they should return home and parents should make other arrangements for them to get to school.

Students arriving by bus will be greeted by a staff member who will escort them to their classrooms.



Arrival and Dismissal

Late Arrivals

After 9:15 AM, please go to the security guard on Lefferts Ave. They will call us to get your daughter. Please allow time for the teacher to get downstairs.

School begins at 9:00 AM. We must impress upon you the importance of having your child in school on time. Any parent that is entering school must be cleared by security and the student's grade department office.

When entering the building, parents should be dressed according to הלכה, wearing a sheitel and elbows, collarbones and legs completely covered.

Pre-1A Dismissal

Monday through Thursday is at **3:45 -4:00 PM**.

Friday dismissal is at **11:45 AM - 12:00 PM**.

Dismissal Areas for Pre-1A:

- **Pick Up** - Exit 3, on Lefferts Ave, under the tent in front of the playground.

For the safety of our children, students should not walk alone between buses, cars or behind garbage trucks to reach your car.

- **Sister Pick Up** - The Pre1A students will be waiting in the lunchroom for their older students who walk them home. They will be seated at a designated table marked "Sister Pick Up," where they can be seen.

- **Bus** - Exit 2, the East NY entrance (wait area - lunchroom)

Transition Dismissal

Monday through Thursday is at **2:45-3:00 PM** at the East New York entrance. Please be on time.

Friday dismissal is at **11:40 AM-12:00 PM** at the Atrium. Please be on time.

Birthdays

מצוה Notes

Please send מצוה notes daily. Each day during Davening, מצוה notes are read aloud. The children feel excited about sharing it with the class and having the notes displayed.



צדקה

One of the most beautiful מצוות that children can actively participate in is the Mitzvah of צדקה. Children's sense of sharing and doing חסד is reinforced by encouraging them to bring a penny every day. Tip: Prepare enough coins for the entire week in a small bag or change purse.



School Uniform

Pre-1A Uniform

The Pre-1A uniform consists of a gray jumper and a pink blouse or pink polo shirt. It has been designed to give the students a feeling of dignity and simplicity, which is the essence of a Bas Yisroel.

In Bais Rivkah, we take pride in our high standard of צניעות. Elbows, knees and collarbones must be covered at all times. Tights are a required part of the Pre-1A dress code. Socks and leggings are not permitted. Nail polish is not permitted. Children develop sensitivity for the beauty of צניעות at a young age, therefore school standards should be applied at home as well.

The Pre1A uniform can be bought at Lands' End, French Toast, Gap, Children's Place and most uniform stores. There are no products at the Bais Rivkah Uniform Store for Pre1A.

Transition Class Dress Code

The transition class does not have a uniform. Elbows, knees and collarbones must be covered at all times. Tights are a required part of the dress code. Socks and leggings are not permitted.
