Associated Beth Rivkah Schools, Division of Higher Learning offers its students a select number of educational opportunities at specific institutions abroad. Courses offered are similar in content and style to those offered at Associated Beth Rivkah Schools, Division of Higher Learning. This gives Associated Beth Rivkah Schools, Division of Higher Learning students the opportunity to broaden their horizons by studying and mingling with students of other cultures in the natural surroundings of those students. These arrangements are approved by our accrediting agency, AIJS.

Study abroad is limited to 30 credits and is only available to students who enroll for the purpose of obtaining the Advanced Classical Torah Studies Degree. Study abroad students must be enrolled for at least one semester at the host school, Associated Beth Rivkah Schools, Division of Higher Learning in Crown Heights, prior to attending the institution abroad.

The method of delivery for the portion of the educational program offered at the Study Abroad Institutions specified below is in person.
